



Traffic and Parking Information



Staff Car Parks

The staff car parks are strictly for **staff only** and dropping off or picking up of your child is not permitted. Children are not permitted to walk through staff car parks.

Prohibition Signs

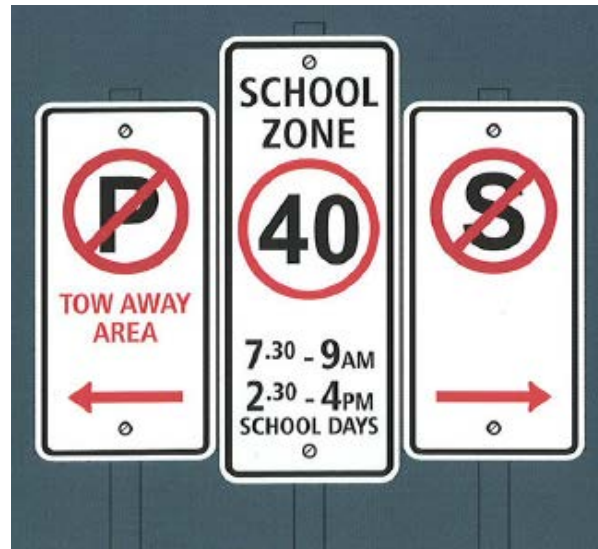
There are two types of prohibitions which have specific meanings under the Road Traffic Code, "No Stopping" and "No Parking".

No Parking

No Parking means that a motorist may stop the vehicle to immediately set down or pick up passengers or goods. The motorist must remain with the vehicle.

No Stopping

No Stopping means that a motorist cannot stop to set down or pick up passengers. Typically these are put in place to ban vehicles from stopping in potentially hazardous areas.



Some Golden Rules of Parking

Do

- Be aware
- Be courteous
- Be responsible
- Be a "perfect parker"
- Use the Kiss & Drive correctly
- Observe parking signs

Don't

- Block driveways
- Park on the footpaths
- Get frustrated
- Obstruct children's crossings
- Be a 'selfish' or 'nasty' parker
- Double park even if you are waiting to enter the Kiss & Drive

At Wanneroo Primary parents and visitors are required to:

- Maintain an anti-clockwise traffic flow around the school (i.e. it is critical to keep the school on your left) so that children exit vehicles from the left on to the verge or footpath.
- Observe all signage, entry and exit points.
- Refrain from parking in the Kiss & Drive. If your child is not waiting when you pull into the bay continue on and drive around the block.
- Refrain from double parking, parking on kerbs or across driveways
- Refrain from "U" turns in Church Street, Frederick Street or Shaw Road as this is against desired traffic flow.
- Refrain from parking or dropping off your child in staff car parks.

Kindergarten and Pre Primary Parents

As the early childhood parents are required to drop off and pick up their children from the classroom, they need to park and leave their vehicle. To assist traffic flow, parents are requested to arrive at school between 8.30am and 8.45am, providing greater drop off space for other parents.

- The seventeen bays on site and accessed from Church Street, are for use of Kindergarten and Pre Primary Parents only.
- When exiting the school, traffic should turn left into Church Street.
- When accessing the kindergarten and pre primary car park, parents and children should use the path and not walk through the car park.

Kiss & Drive

The Kiss & Drive principle can only operate successfully if all parents cooperate to allow for the free flow of traffic. The designated Kiss & Drive is located on Shaw Road.

- Parking is not permitted in this area. Please note the City of Wanneroo rangers now have the right to fine anyone who does not comply with this parking regulation.
- If your child is not waiting for you when you come through it is critical to move on and allow the cars behind to move into the bay.
- You put the safety of our students at risk if you remain waiting as it causes other cars to back up down Shaw Road creating a situation where children are forced onto the road to access their car.

Staff Parking

The staff car parks are strictly for staff only and dropping off or picking up of your child is not permitted. Children are not permitted to walk through the staff car parks.

Additional Drop Off Points and Parking

- 1. Wanneroo Road**
 - Parents are encouraged to use the marked bays behind the fast food outlets on Wanneroo Road, adjacent to the school.
- 2. Shaw Road**
 - Parallel kerbside parking is permitted on both sides of Shaw Road.
 - Kiss & Drive bays (no standing/parking) are now located on the school side of Shaw Road between the times of 2.50 – 3.10 pm.
 - Students crossing Shaw Road should do so at the crossover at the corner of Keane Street and Shaw Road.
- 3. Keane Street**
 - Parallel kerbside parking/stopping is permitted in Keane Street.
- 4. Frederick Street**
 - Parallel kerbside parking/stopping is permitted on the school side of Frederick Street.
- 5. Church Street**
 - Parallel kerbside parking / stopping is permitted on the school side of Church Street.
- 6. Taywood Drive**
 - Students accessing the school from Taywood Drive should cross with the traffic Warden in Church Street and follow the paths into school.

Buses

The Kiss & Drive area becomes a designated official bus zone after 3.10 pm. Vehicles may not be left parked in this area.



The rangers from the City of Wanneroo have advised the school that illegal parking may lead to a Notice of Infringement placed on the vehicle or a photograph of an offending vehicle taken and an infringement posted out.

As a school that values the well being of our families we all have a civic responsibility to follow the procedures for safe traffic flow and parking as outlined in this brochure. If there is a member of our school community who is not aware of the guidelines please remind them politely of the need for safety. If everyone is courteous, considerate and does the right thing then we would not need the intervention of the City of Wanneroo rangers.
